DID YOU KNOW?

On March 18, 2021 Bill C-7 was passed, thereby expanding access to medical assistance in dying (MAID), in Canada. The new law removes numerous safeguards, as well as broadens access to MAID to include non-terminally ill patients and disabled individuals. Since the bill was passed, there has been a marked increase in the number of euthanasia deaths in Canada. Looking at Ontario, in 2021 there was an increase of 30%, bringing the number of euthanasia deaths to 3,102.

In February 2022, The Protection of Freedom of Conscience Act (Bill C-230), a new private members bill, was introduced in the House of Commons by MP Kelly Block. The bill aims to provide legal protection of conscience rights for medical professionals who object to participating in assisted suicide. By ensuring the conscience rights of doctors and other medical professionals, the integrity of the doctor-patient relationship is maintained, and by extension, the rights of patients with disabilities and serious illness are also protected. Let us pray that this bill will be passed.
