
#### **#HEROESOFHOPE**

## The One Heart, One Soul Campaign

Beginning in 2019, the One Heart, One Soul Campaign inspired thousands of parishioners to invest in the future of their local parish and our wider Diocesan community - providing a profound sign of hope. As of 2025, nearly \$39 million has been raised, with over 120 parishes and missions raising funds for projects ranging from accessibility upgrades to roof repairs, new and enhanced ministries, restoration of historic art and stained glass, and even new construction of churches and parish centres. In addition to the individual parish and mission projects, each gift further helped build ministries of hope across the Diocese, including university and hospital chaplaincies, prison ministry, migrant worker ministry.

Each pledge provided to the campaign represents a powerful expression of hope. Every gift — large or small — has helped to sustain our community of faith and enabled us to bring the hope of the Gospel more effectively to a world deeply in need.



## A Hope that Endures

For so many in our Diocese, generosity continues beyond their lifetime. Through a bequest or planned gift, Catholics are able to leave a legacy of faith. Whether through a gift in a Will, a life insurance policy, or a donation of securities, these contributions create an enduring source of support for the Church's mission.


There are so many examples of generous bequests to the Diocese, but one recent example is particularly striking. One long-time parishioner left to the Diocese her home and some investments she and her late husband had accumulated over many years. A strong real estate market and great market returns meant that her bequest resulted in a multi-million dollar gift to the Church. The donor's wish was for her gift to allow the Bishop to assist local parishes and charities in need adding a multiplying effect to an already-generous gift. Over the past few years, dozens of parishes and other local charities have benefitted from this one generous gift. The ripple effect created by one generous person can truly make a lasting mark on the work of the Church.
